### **Cole Hudson Memorial Scholarship**

A minimum of three \$500 Scholarships to be awarded to a Rodeo Student that has completed 24 credit hours. (Scholarship amount may be more based on funds available).

#### **WHAT IS THE SCHOLARSHIP PROGRAM?**

The Cole Hudson Memorial scholarship foundation offers a scholarship program in which students share in fulfilling the same love for rodeo as Cole did. Students who are awarded this scholarship will have completed a minimum of 24 college credits. The financial aid will be provided with check each semester upon proof of enrollment to use at any College or University of their choice. The student has to complete the semester with passing grades of 2.5 or better. Failure to complete the semester or fulfill the grade requirements will result in a suspension of the 2<sup>nd</sup> semester scholarship money. **An application is required, completed and must be returned to Hudson Rodeo Co, 1485 Bumpy Road, Sharon Springs, KS 67758.** The Hudson family will review each application and make the final decision, scholarship winners to be announced on May 25, 2018 and awarded prior to the start of the Fall Semester.

#### **WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR THE SCHOLARSHIP?**

To be considered for a scholarship, an applicant must:

- 1· Demonstrate high academic promise and achievement in high school or college.
- 2· Demonstrate a high level of motivation.
- 3· Be admitted to a college or university.
- 4· Demonstrate outstanding character, integrity, and citizenship within your community.
- 5· Must be a graduate of high school, or attending a college/university.

#### **TERMS OF THE SCHOLARSHIP**

Applicant is expected to:

- 1· Maintain a 2.5 cumulative GPA.
- 2· Carry 12 semester hours or full time student status.

#### **INFORMATION TO INCLUDE WITH APPLICATION—APP DEADLINE IS MAY 15, 2018**

##### **A ESSAY 500 WORD MINIMUM**

1. Write a brief autobiography. Include your general outlook on life.
2. Selected an event in your life that you consider most significant, or an event that has caused a change in your life. Discuss how this event affected you.
3. Briefly discuss your professional goals and how you hope to achieve them.

##### **B VOLUNTEER ACTIVITIES**

1. List any volunteer activities that you are or have been involved in.

##### **C LETTERS OF RECOMMENDATION**

1. If you have any letter of recommendation from your school teacher, employer, minister, etc., please send them along with your application.

##### **Honors list**

1. List any honors received, clubs, and social activities participated in, as well as your interests and talents.

##### **D TRANSCRIPTS**

1. Please send transcripts from high school, and from any college or university attended.
